RE: CDBG CV grant funds

As the Commission is aware the City received a 2020 Small Cities Community Development, CDBG CV grant, in the amount of \$167,000 to fund Community CARES Act projects. There is \$132,000 allocated for Economic Development Micro Grants and \$35,000 for meal programs. The city is required to contribute at least \$15,000 in other sources of funds for this project.

Our grant representative and Casey Woods will be at the meeting to discuss the application and rating criteria. They will provide a revised draft based on recommendations from the July 22nd commission meeting.

Receive information from grant administrator and discuss options. Approve application and rating process at an upcoming action meeting.
